Le sheikh Muslihuddin Saadi Shirazi fut, dans le florissant XIIe siècle de Bagdad, l'un des maîtres soufis les plus célèbres et les plus respectés. The Persian Mirror explores France's preoccupation with Persia in the seventeenth century. Long before Montesquieu's Persian Letters, French intellectuals, diplomats and even ordinary Parisians were fascinated by Persia and eagerly consumed travel accounts, fairy tales, and the spectacle of the Persian ambassador's visit to Paris and Versailles in 1715. Using diplomatic sources, fiction and printed and painted images, The Persian Mirror describes how the French came to see themselves in Safavid Persia. In doing so, it revises our notions of orientalism and the exotic and suggests that early modern Europeans had more nuanced responses to Asia than previously imagined.

Alison Finch's wide-ranging analysis of some 60 writers reflects the rich diversity of a century that begins with Mme de Staël's cosmopolitanism and ends with Rachilde's perverse eroticism. Composition allégorique et subversive fondatrice du genre, le Roman de la Rose est un long poème courtois. Commencé par Guillaume de Lorris, quarante ans plus tard par Jehan de Meun qui en écrivit la plus grande partie dans un style tout différent. Cet ouvrage propose, outre le texte lui-même, les analyses savantes et les biographies des auteurs par d'éminents érudits du XIX^e siècle : Pierre Marteau, André Thévet, Jean-Jacques Ampère, et Jean-Christien-Ferdinand Hofer. Le texte reprend tous les codes des romans chevaleresques (amours, aventure, merveilleux, chevalerie) mais en profite pour soulever une controverse sociale en utilisant des thèmes sulfureux et misogynes. Le roman de la Rose reste l'un des piliers de la littérature médiévale, et influença profondément des auteurs tels que Chaucer (the Canterbury Tales).
