1947, I was,

amongst other things, assigned the task of teaching Malay literature in an advanced teacher-training course, with the instruction to lay stress on modern literature. This was easier said than done, as very little had been written on the subject, and few materials were available to me. From this period I recall with great gratitude the regular and friendly

contacts I had with Mr. Sutan Takdir Alisjahbana, who in many ways met me with information and documentation. He helped the editor of the magazine "Kritiek en Opbouw" find my lecture notes on some pre-war authors worth publishing. These articles, with an introduction on Bahasa Indonesia and some other additions, were subsequently collected and published by Pembangunan

under the title *Voltooid Voorspel* (Completed Prelude) (Jakarta 1950). The little book sold fairly quickly, but rather than publishing a new edition in Dutch the publisher was interested in bringing out an Indonesian adaptation. Much material was added, the larger part of which had been collected by writing occasional reviews of Indonesian literary works for the Dutch
